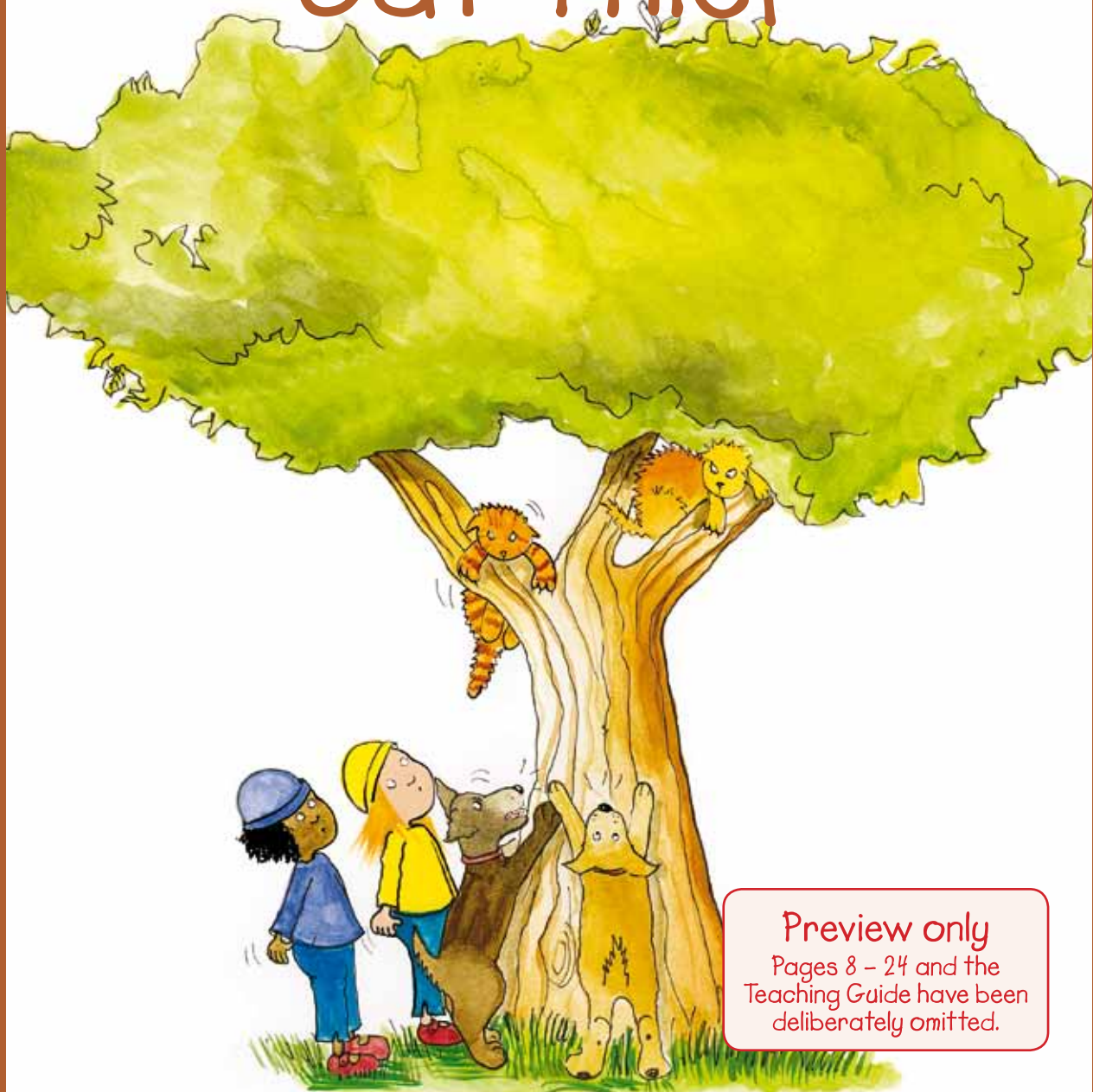
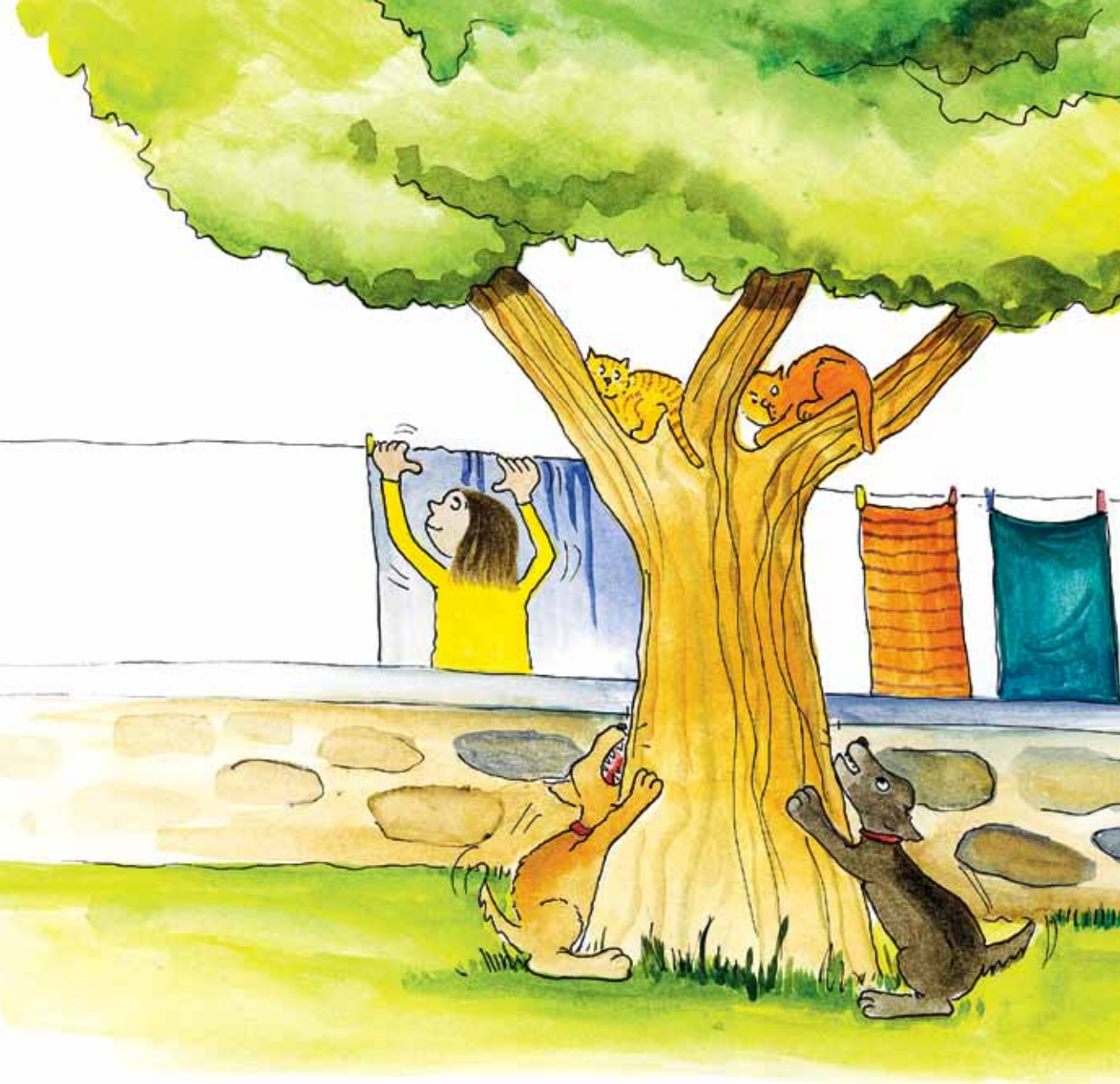

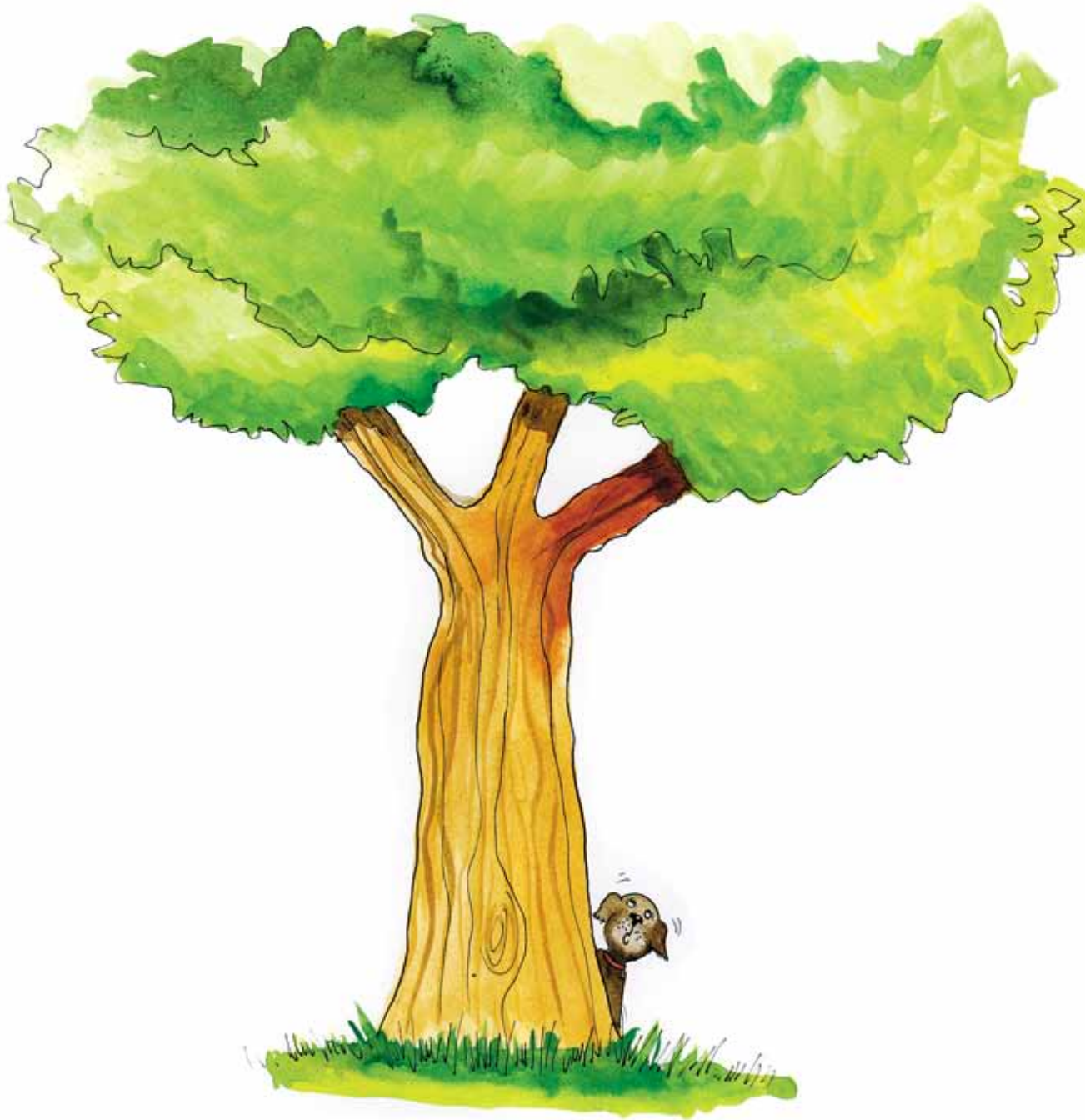
Barker and Bouncer barked raucously at every situation.
