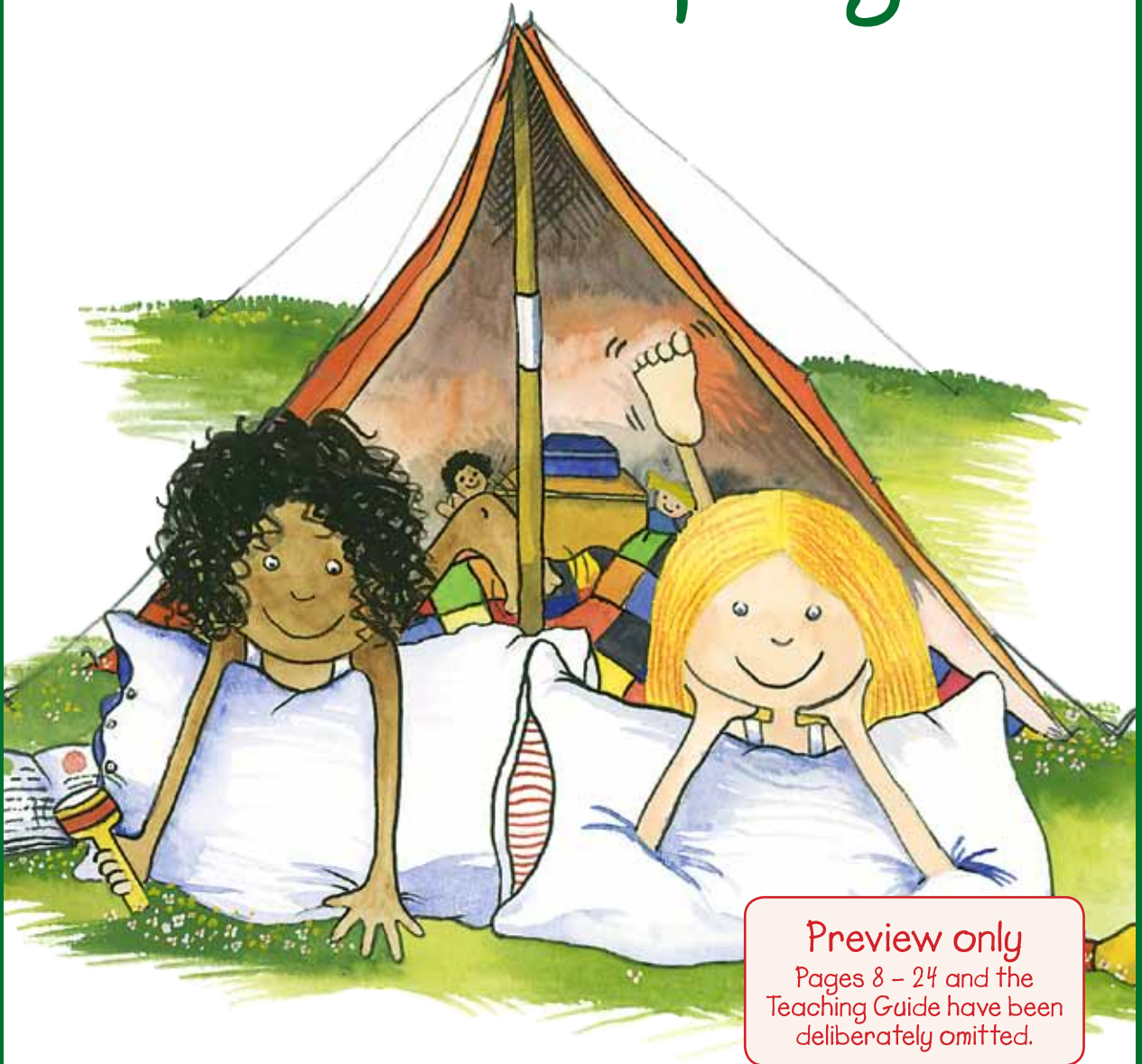


# Milly and Molly Go Camping

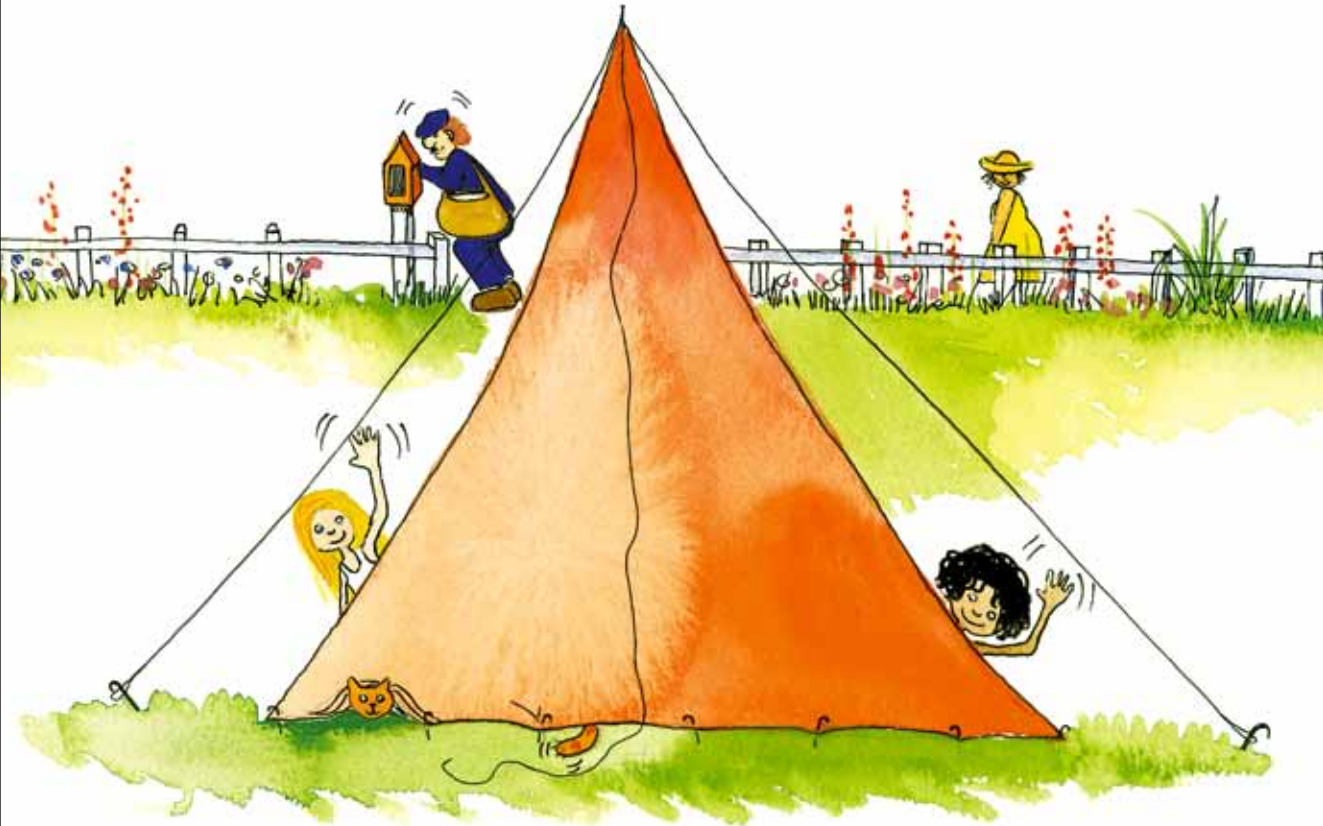
Every summer Milly and Molly pulled the old tent out of the coat closet under the stairs.



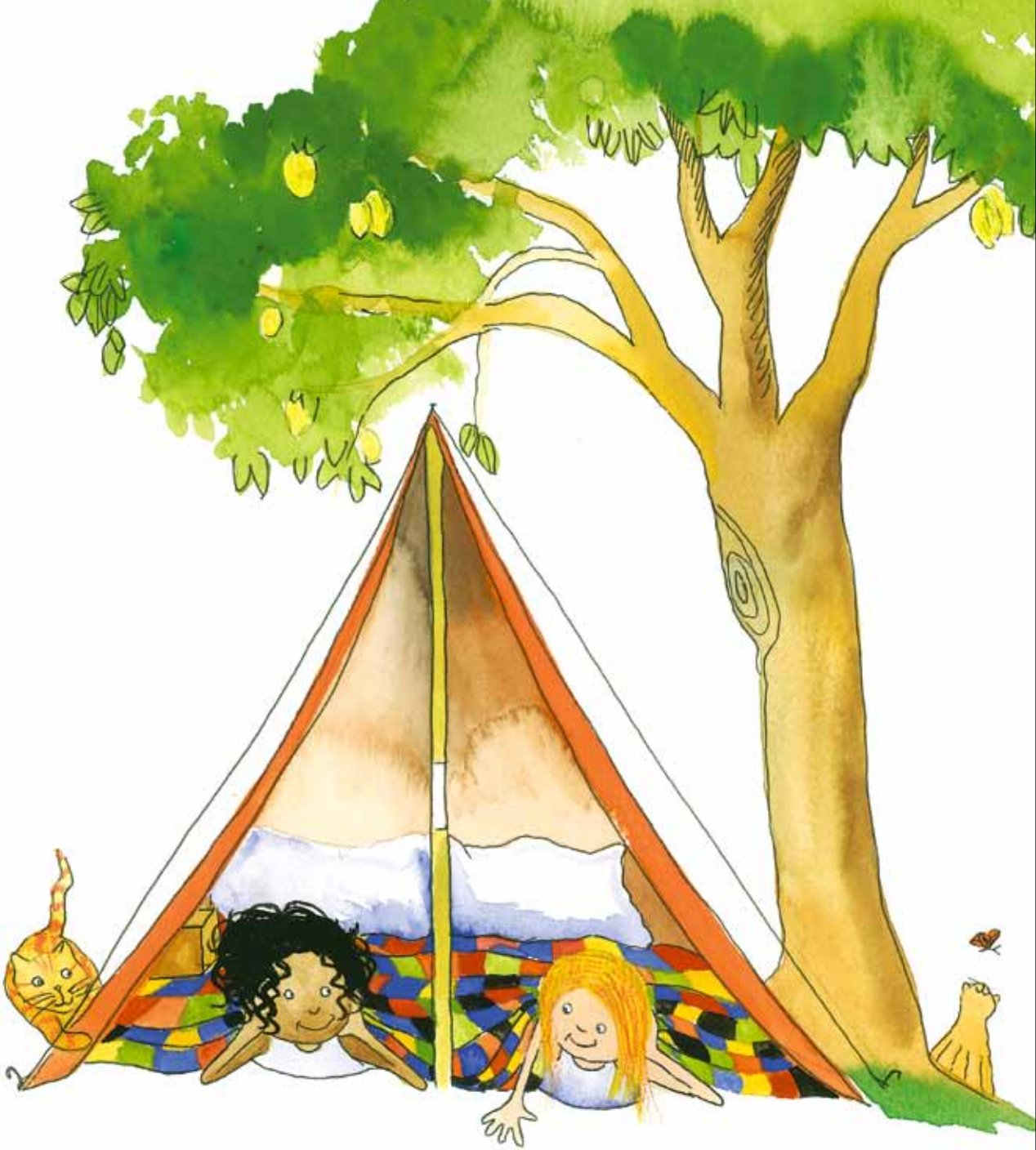
Their dads always helped them put it up.
