“It was my job to keep the woodbox full,



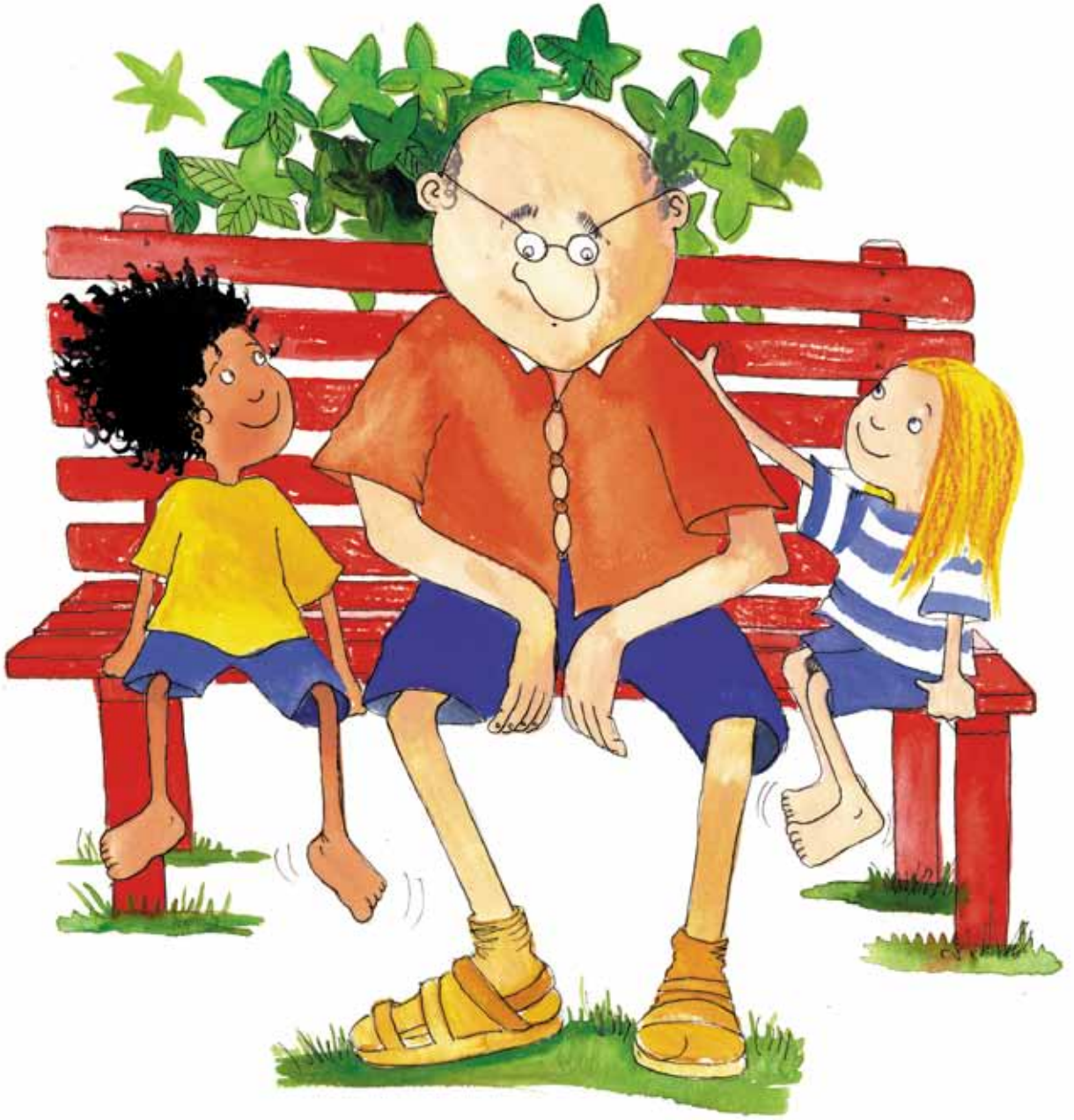
the wood burner stoked,

from the well

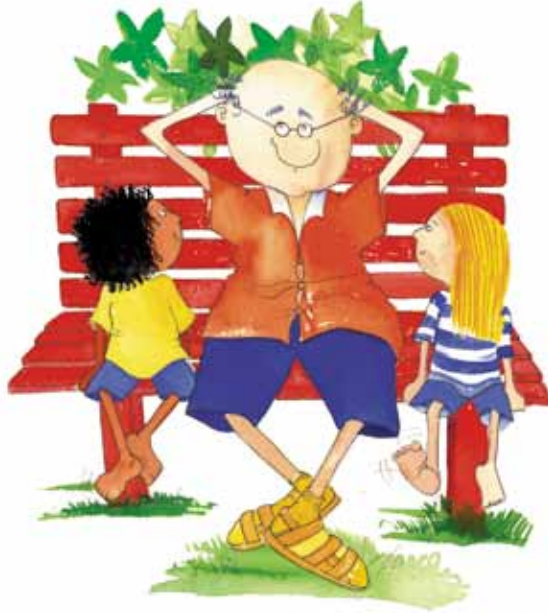


and the floors swept.”
