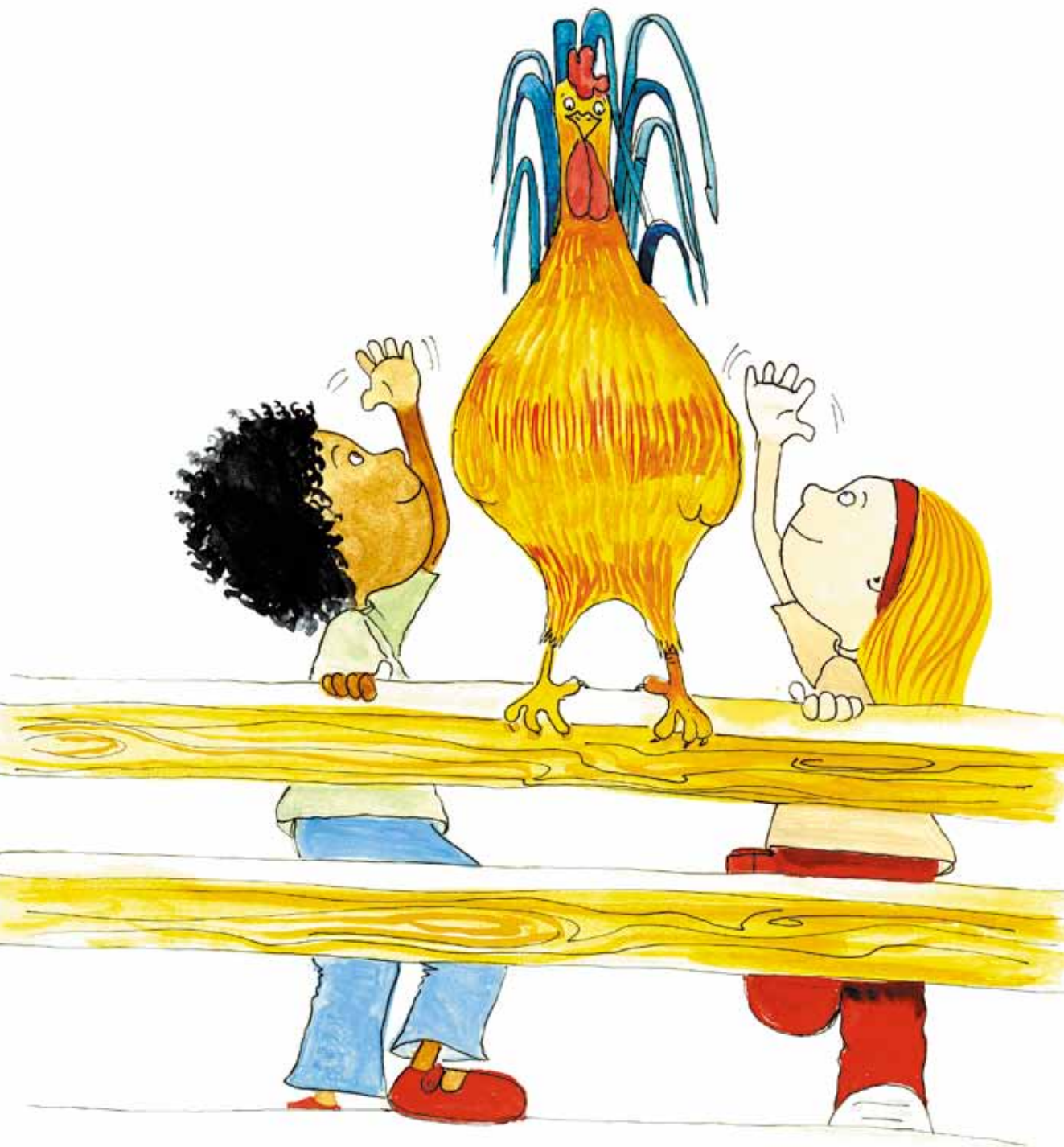
Mr. Rooster had a secret.
