Every year Milly and Molly entered the three-legged race



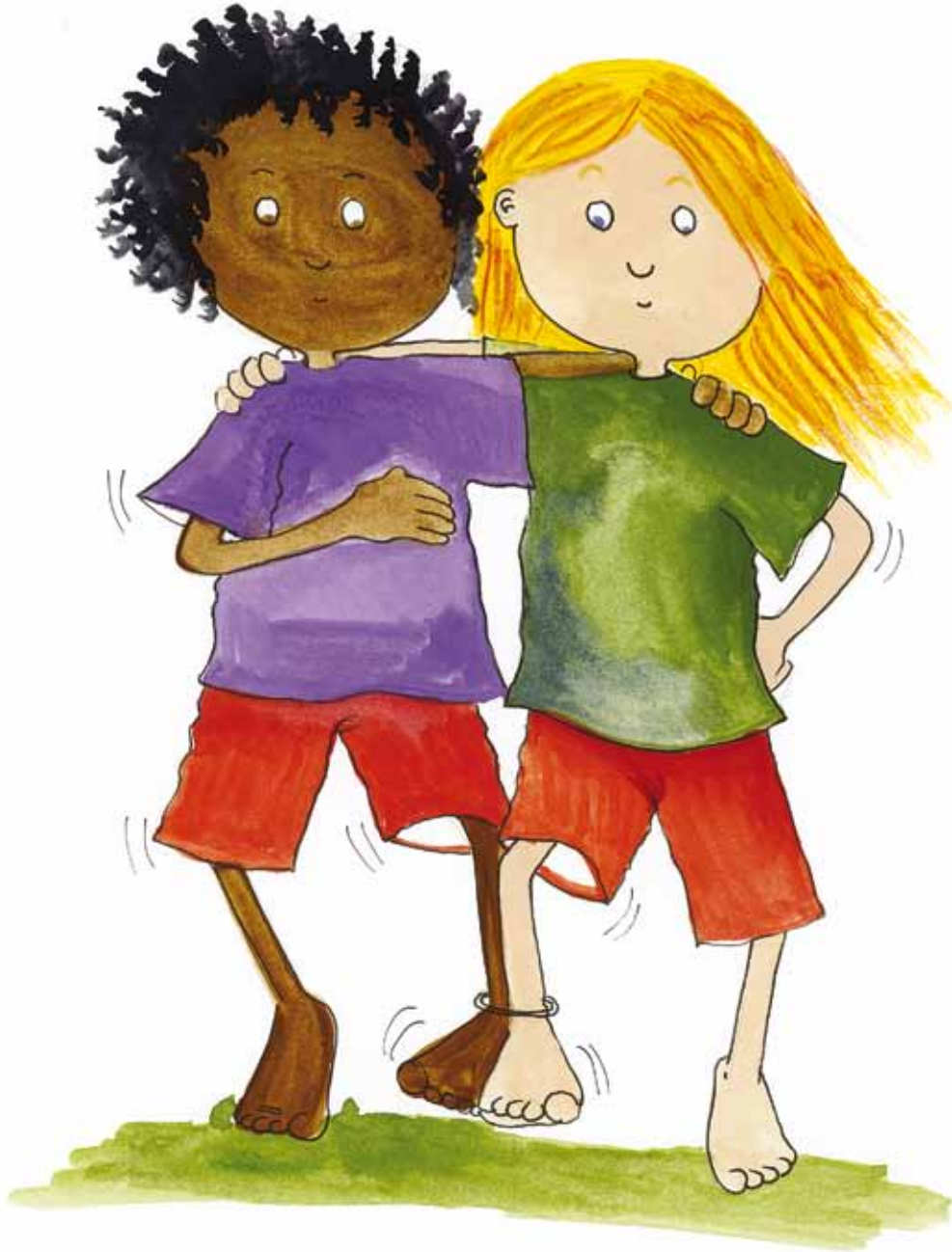
and every year they won.
