The value implicitly expressed in this story is ‘control of anger’ - coping with feelings of annoyance in a non-aggressive way.

When Pennyroyal’s behaviour becomes completely disruptive she is banished to a place on her own, which only fuels her anger. Farmer Hegarty shows Pennyroyal the ugly face of anger - her face. Ashamed, Pennyroyal learns to control her anger.
